Medical Emergency Response Plan



*This algorithm is to be available to all staff as a tool to aid with decision making while responding to minor and major medical emergencies involving students, other staff, or visitors to the school or while on school sponsored trips. Every medical emergency is different and proper judgement should be always be used. **When in doubt call 911.***

Examine/speak with injured/sick individual.

Are they **breathing** and **alert**?

Are they reporting severe difficulty breathing, chest pain or have signs of severe bleeding?

If **YES** to any of the above call 9-1-1 immediately and notify Principal/Nurse/Pastor, who will notify child's parents (if applicable). Trained staff should administer CPR/epi-pen/first aid as appropriate for situation until EMS arrives.

If **NO** then trained staff should administer first aid and contact Principal/Nurse/Pastor. Office staff will contact parents (if applicable) to discuss if child needs medical treatment emergently.
